## 2007 RIIGIKOGU ELECTION RESULTS

On Sunday 4 March 2007, the elections for the 11<sup>th</sup> Estonian Parliament were held.

Eleven parties contested the 101 mandates available in the elections, six of them gained the required five per cent vote threshold to qualify for the distribution of mandates:

\* Pro Patria Union and Res Publica were two separate parties at the time of 2003 elections. They merged in June 2006.

\*\* The Social Democratic Party was named 'Mõõdukad' ('Moderates') from April 1996 to February 2004.

\*\*\* The party Estonian Greens was founded in November 2006.
